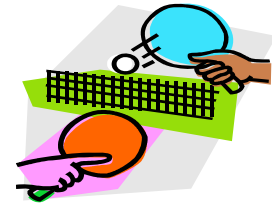

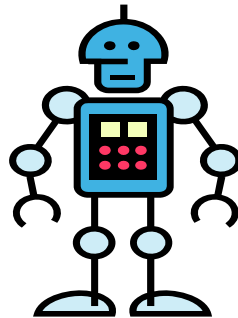
## **LEGO® Mindstorms® NXT Robotics Engineering II**

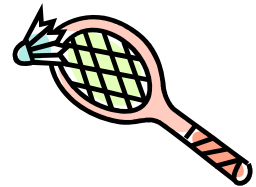
