Program Opportunities and Activities

Young adolescents enjoy participating in meaningful and tangible projects and activities. They thrive in programs that enhance their self-esteem and offer them opportunities for leadership. Positive social interaction with peers as well as adults is very important at this time in the lives of middle schoolers. At "KU", they will be exposed to a wide variety of challenging and interesting learning experiences such as:

- Card games, Trivia, having a "hang-out" area with music, cd players, board games, etc. as well as a "private space", where they can spend quiet time with a friend or by themselves, is always available.
- Outdoor recreation - both organized games as well as free time;
- Cooking/baking their own snack;
- A variety of activities such as filming and editing videos, community service, sports, "inventions", cartooning, beading, computers, team building as well as field trips.

Homework

We believe that (young adolescent's) academic needs must be balanced with the need to relax, have snacks, learn new life skills, get exercise, learn about the world around them, as well as develop social skills.

At "KU", homework time will be set aside each day (except Friday). Research has shown that middle schoolers need to spend between 45 minutes to 1 hour of doing homework per day. During that time our staff will help them enhance their attitude towards homework and learning by offering skill-building activities such as spelling and math contests, science experiments and other simple learning-focused activities. This will all be offered in an up-beat and encouraging environment for completing homework and mastering the skills involved in assignments.
